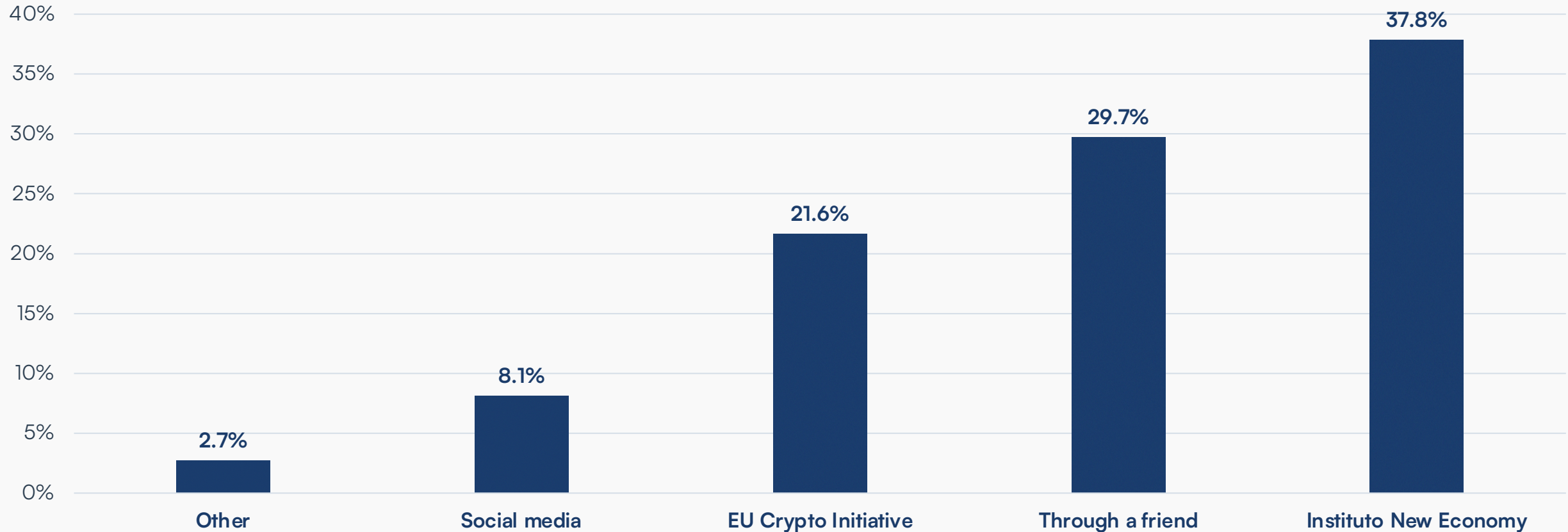
Overall, how would you rate this first edition of The Reg3 Conference?

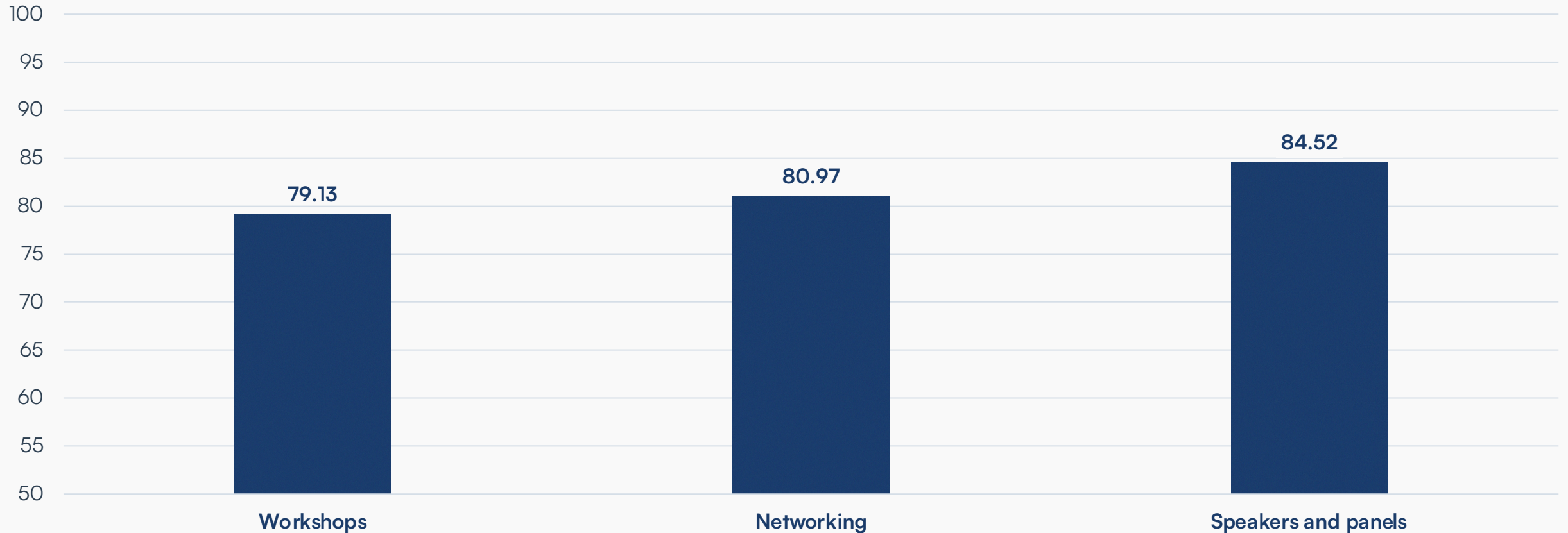

From 0 to 100, how interested were you on the following aspects of conference? — Average score.

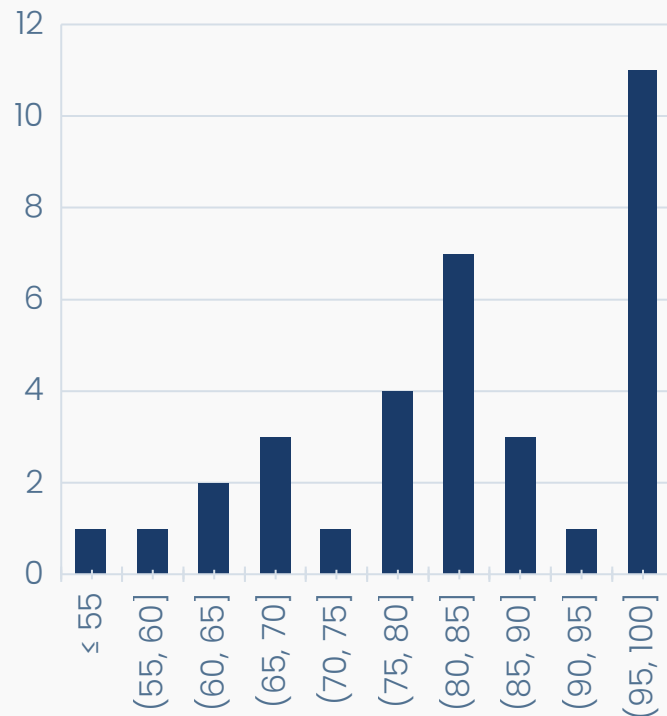




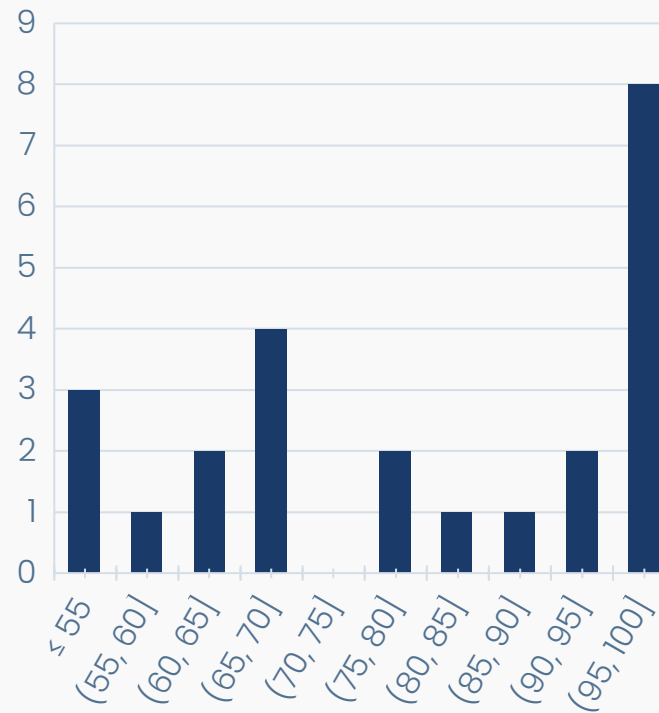

From 0 to 100, how interested were you on the following aspects of conference? — Histograms.

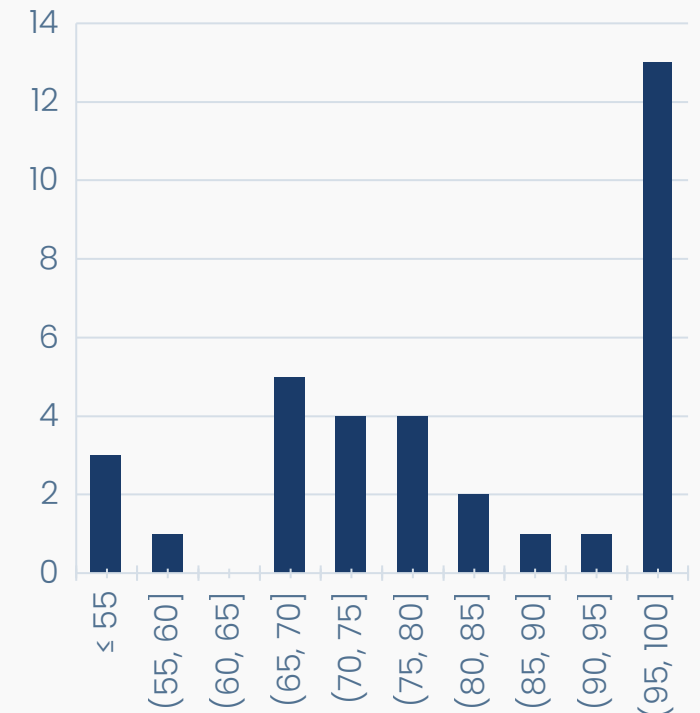

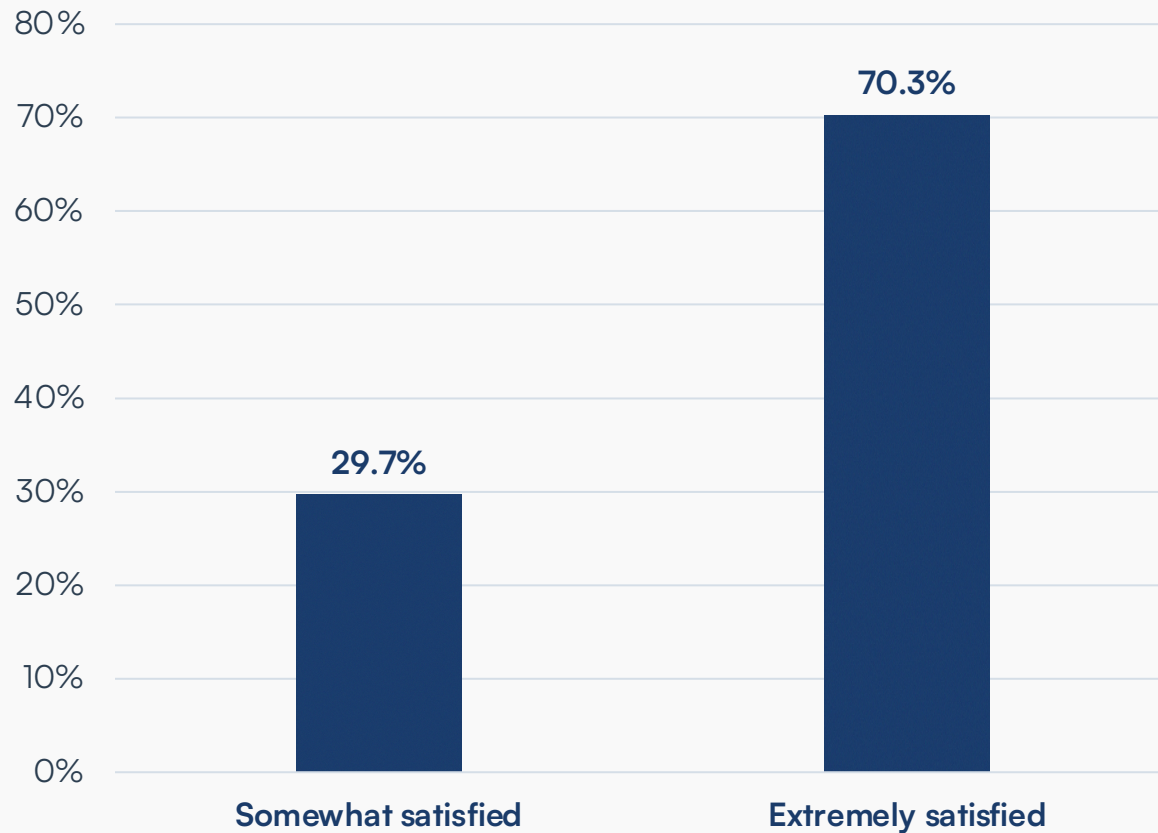
From 0 to 100, how interested were you on the following aspects of conference? — Histograms.



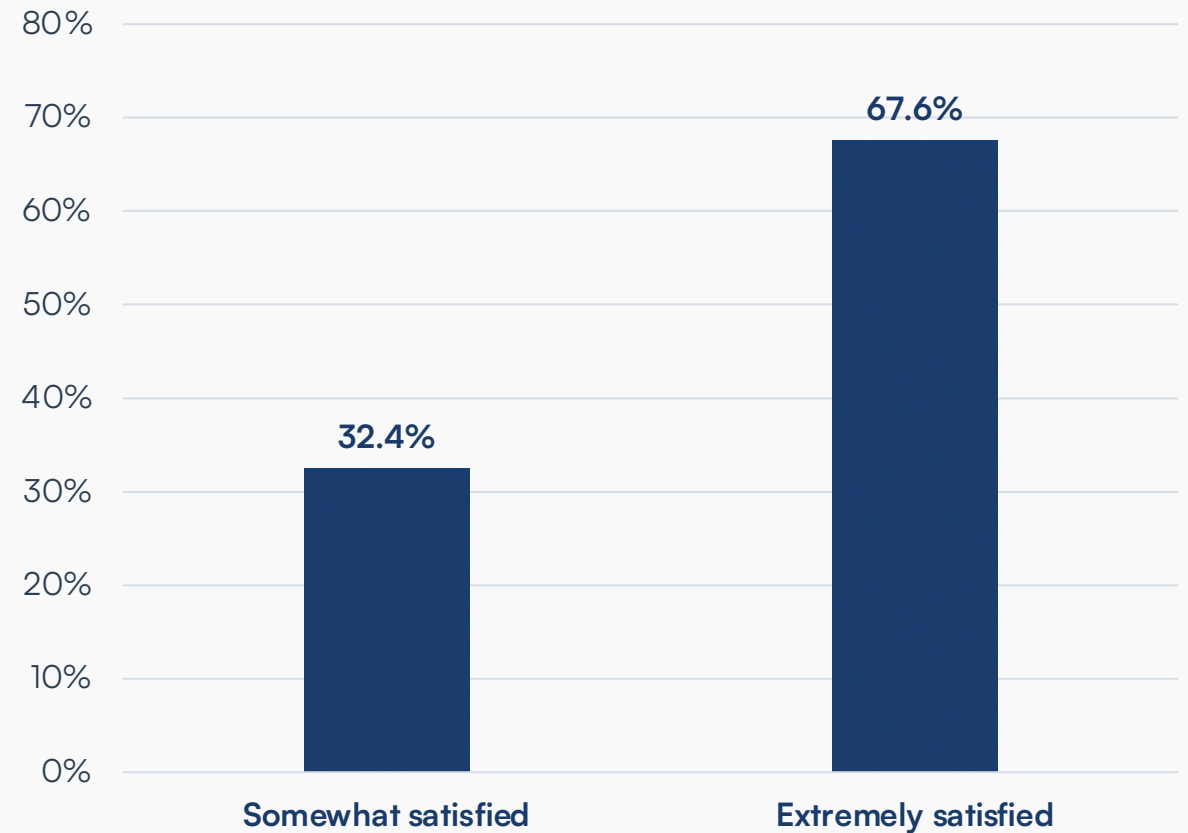


# Attendees were quite satisfied with the speakers and topics.

How satisfied were you with the speakers?



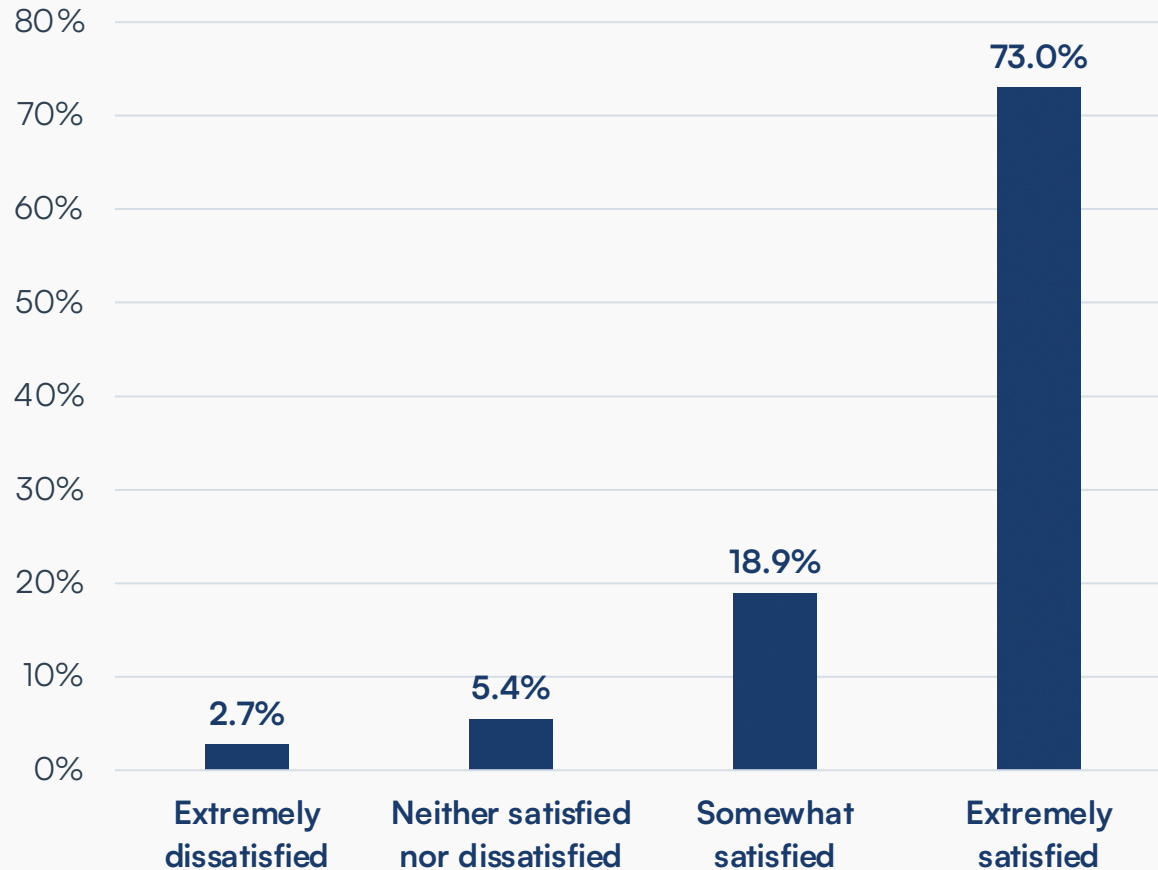
How satisfied were you with the topics?



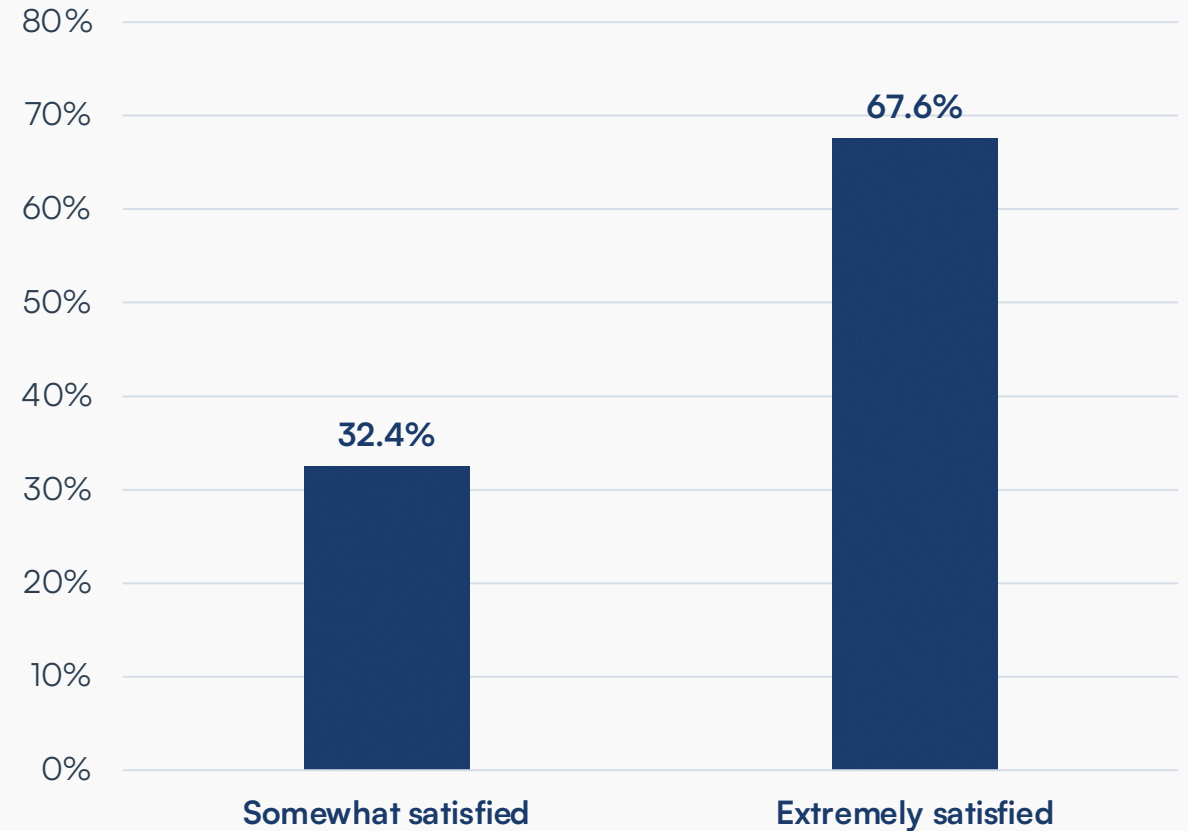

How satisfied were you with the date?



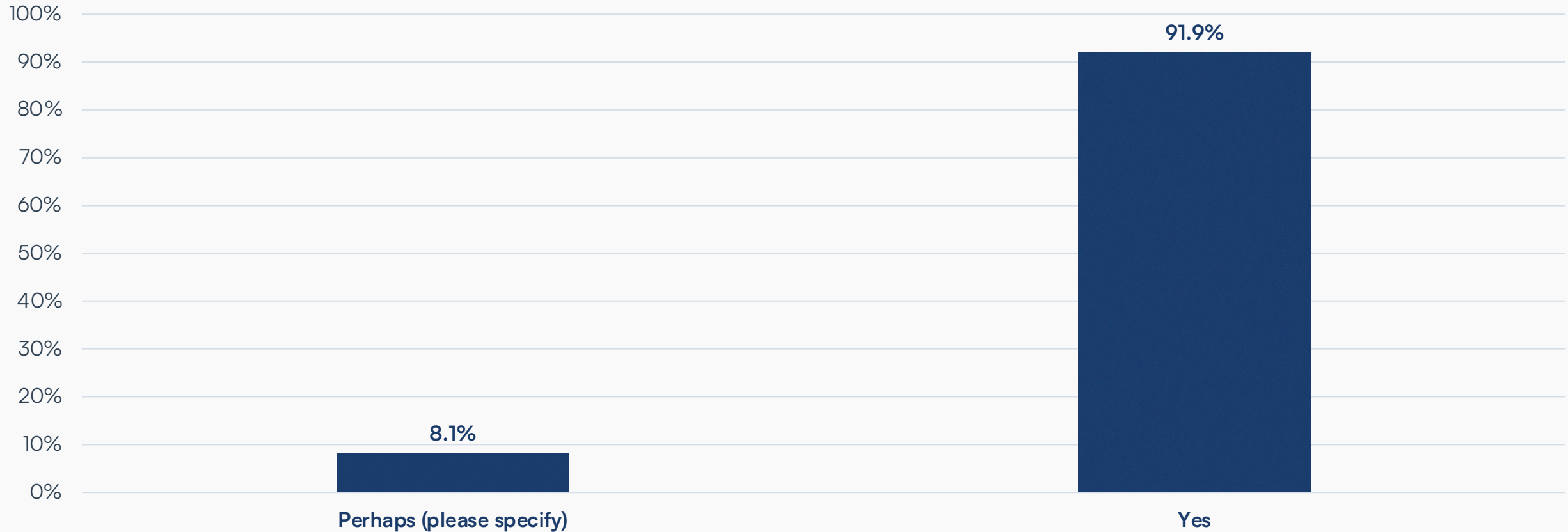

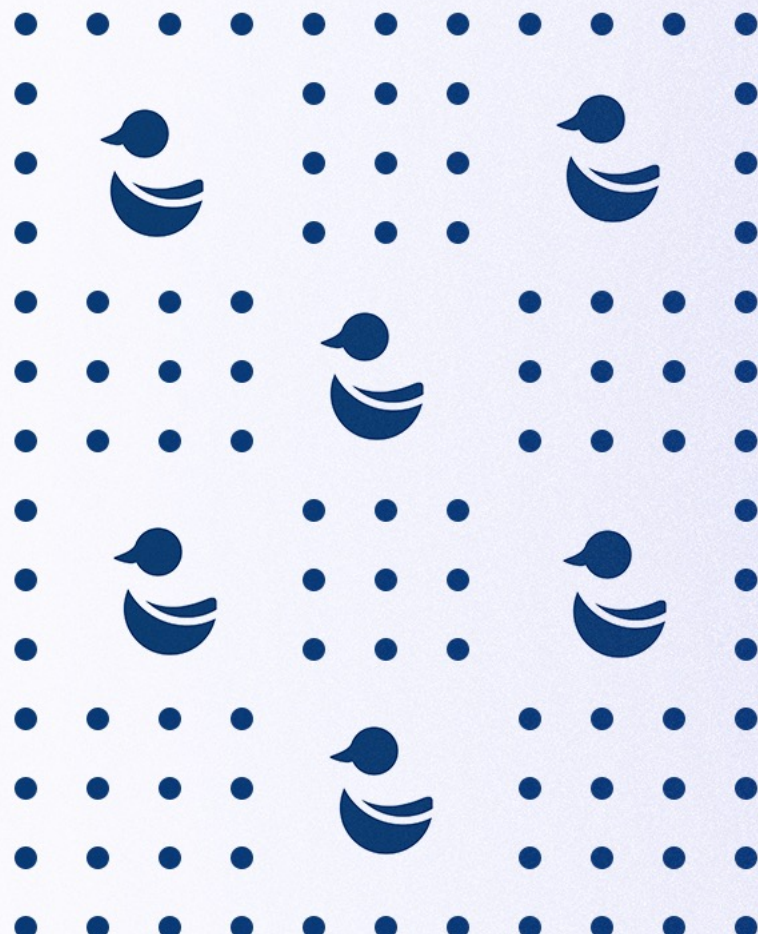

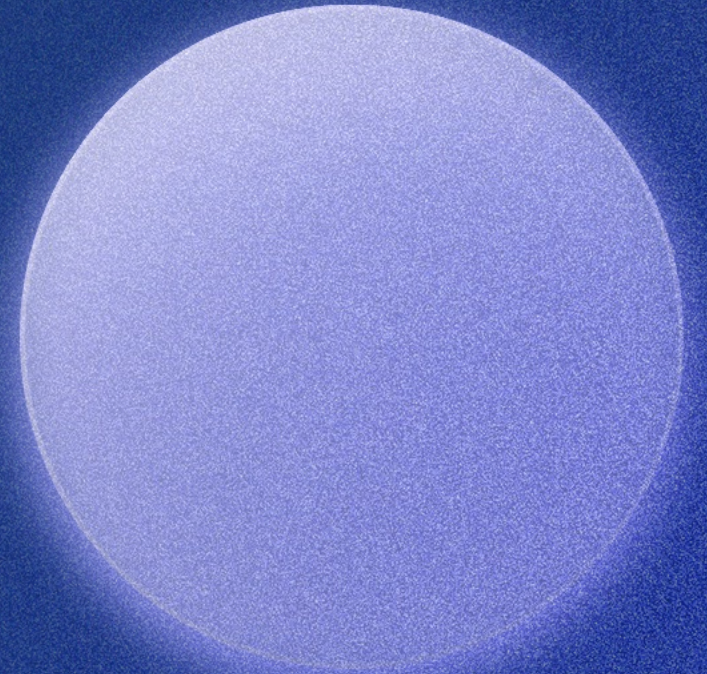
